Triangles Collection by Bertjan Pot for Golran

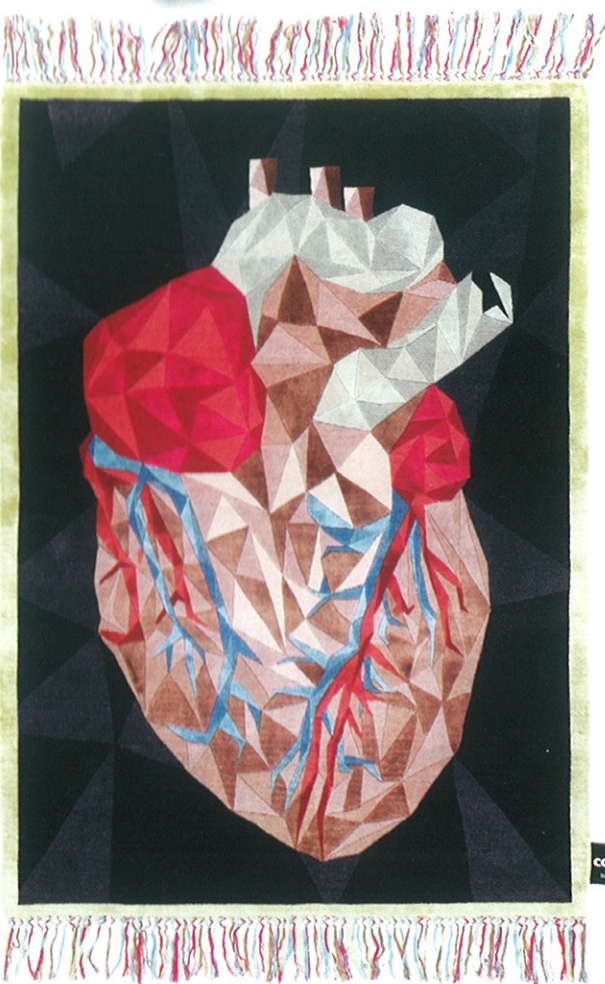
